On the 5th October 1839 St Michael's Church was consecrated as a 'Chapel of Ease' to St Mary's, Prestwich.

The plainly decorated seats in the church were let to members of the congregation at 9d each per quarter or 3s 4d per annum. When the gallery was built in 1855 seats there were 4s per annum!
